

ORDINANCE # _____, 1961

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE KEEPING OF PONIES, HORSES, COWS, SHEEP AND HOGS WITHIN THE TOWN OF ROANN AND PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND REPEALING ANY ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Roann, Indiana:

It shall be unlawful for any person and/or corporation to keep, pen, house, stake or stall ponies, horses, cows, sheep or hogs within the corporate limits of the Town of Roann, Indiana.

All Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Any person or corporation who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined in an amount of not less than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) or more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for each violation.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation and publication in accordance with the law.
