

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MOAWN, INDIANA, TO  
 REDUCE APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND AND  
 MOTOR VEHICLE HIGHWAY FUND FOR THE 1979 BUDGET

Due to reduced monetary needs, and to help and assist funding for the 1980 Budget without an unnecessary tax levy, the Town adopts the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED, that to help fund 1980 Budget without an unnecessary tax levy we hereby reduce the balance of appropriations in the General Fund as of June 30, 1979, from \$33,697.00 to \$29,947.00. We further reduce the Motor Vehicle Highway Fund appropriations from \$14,250.00 to \$9,185.00.
