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GENERAL ORDINANCE # 11, 1956

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT DIGGING
OR EXCAVATING IN THE STREETS AND
ALLEYS AND REGARDING CURBINGS

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Trustees of the Town of
Roann, Indiana:

SECTION I. That it shall be unlawful for any person or
corporation to excavate or make holes in the surface of any
street or alley in the Town of Roann for any purpose without
first obtaining a written permit for that purpose from the
Town Clerk and depositing with said Clerk the sum of One
hundred dollars (\$100.00) as a guarantee that said town will
be reimbursed for the expense of putting said street or alley
in as good a condition as it was prior to the said excavation.

SECTION II. All sums deposited shall be held in a separate
fund known as the "Street and Sewer Deposit Fund". Said fund
shall not be subject to appropriation, and expenditures from
said fund shall be limited to reimbursement of the "Street
Fund" for labor and material used in the repair of the damage
done by each excavation for which a permit is issued, and to
refund to the depositor such portion of the deposit as may
not have been used for repair of the particular area damaged
by said depositor in making the excavations or holes in the
street or alley.

In the event the deposit should prove insufficient to re-
pair the damaged area or areas, the person or corporation shall
be billed for said deficiency, and shall forthwith pay the same.

SECTION III. All such repairs shall be done by the Town Street
Department and paid for by the person securing the permit as above
indicated.

SECTION IV. It shall be unlawful to cut any curbing in said
Town without first obtaining a written permit to do so from the
Town Clerk. Deposits, in an amount to be from time to time set
by the Board of Trustees, shall be required as a prerequisite

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to the issuance of said permits. Said Deposits shall be handled in the same manner as those required for excavation of streets and alleys.

SECTION V. Any new curbings constructed on any streets in the Town of Roann shall be constructed in accordance with specifications approved by the Board of Trustees and shall be at such distance from the center of the street as may be approved by said Board. Once a set-back distance has been approved by the Board for a particular street, all other curbings on said street shall conform to the original set-back specifications.

SECTION VI. It shall be unlawful for any person or corporation to construct any curbing in the Town of Roann which does not conform to specifications approved in writing by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Roann.

SECTION VII. Any person or corporation who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance by failing or refusing to comply with its provisions as herein directed shall be fined in any sum not less than \$10.00 or more than \$50.00.

SECTION VIII. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
