

GENERAL ORDINANCE # 28, 1960

BEING AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE
ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT DIGGING
OR EXCAVATING IN STREETS AND ALLEYS AND
REGARDING CURBINGS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town
of Roann, Indiana:

SECTION I. That Section I of General Ordinance #11,
1956, entitled "An Ordinance To Prohibit Digging Or Excavating
In Streets And Alleys And Regarding Curbings" shall be amended
to read as follows:

That it shall be unlawful for any person or corporation
to excavate or make holes in the surface of any street or alley
in the Town of Roann for any purpose without first obtaining
a written permit for that purpose from the Town Clerk and deposit-
ing with said Clerk the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) as a
guarantee that said town will be reimbursed for the expense of
putting said street or alley in as good condition as it was
prior to the said excavation.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and
effect from and after its passage and publication as provided
by law.
