

GENERAL ORDINANCE #10, 1956

BEING AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING
TRAFFIC REGULATIONS AND DESIGNA-
TING CERTAIN STREETS AS STOP STREETS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Roann:

SECTION 1. - That Adams Street going West from the corporation line at the West edge of the Roann High School grounds is hereby designated as a one-way street to Ohio Street, and is shall be unlawful to drive a vehicle in an easterly direction over said designated portion of said street.

SECTION 2. That vehicles traveling west on Adams Street shall stop in observance of the stop sign at Arnold Street and vehicles traveling east on Adams street shall stop in observance of the stop sign at Arnold Street, and that it shall be unlawful to fail to bring all vehicles to a complete stop at said points before proceeding and to fail to yield the right-of-way to vehicles crossing Adams Street at Arnold Street.

SECTION 3. That the intersection at Pike and Church Streets is hereby designated a four-way stop and all vehicles proceeding in any direction shall stop in observance of the stop-signs at said intersection before proceeding with caution, and shall not enter said intersection when any other vehicle which has stopped in observance of a stop-sign is already entering said intersection from the intersecting street.

SECTION 4. That vehicles traveling west on Quincy Street shall stop in observance of the stop sign at Church Street and vehicles traveling east on Quincy Street shall stop in observance of the stop sign at Church Street, and that it shall be unlawful to fail to bring all vehicles to a complete stop at said points before proceeding and to fail to yield the right-of-way to vehicles crossing Quincy Street at Church Street.

SECTION 5. That all of said streets and intersections are

within the Corporate limits of the Town of Roann, Indiana.

SECTION 6. That any person found guilty of violation of any section of this ordinance shall be fined not less than one dollar (\$1.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00).

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
