

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO.   7   - 1982

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE NORTH-SOUTH ALLEY BETWEEN WALNUT AND ALLEN STREETS AS A ONE-WAY ALLEY SOUTHBOUND

WHEREAS the Roann State Exchange Bank has installed a drive-up window on the west side of the bank for automobile traffic to do business with the bank while an occupant of an automobile; and

WHEREAS to avoid the possibility of traffic congestion in the north-south alley between Walnut and Allen Streets in the Town of Roann it is necessary to make the alley one-way, southbound;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby ordained by the Town Board of Trustees of the Town of Roann, Indiana, as follows:

1. The north-south alley between Chippewa and Washington Streets and extending from Allen Street to Walnut Street within the Town of Roann is hereby designated a one-way alley southbound.

2. It shall be unlawful for a vehicle to travel northbound in the alley between Chippewa and Washington Streets from Walnut to Allen Streets in the Town of Roann.

3. The bank, at no cost or expense to the town, shall install one-way signs at the exit of the alley onto Walnut Street which signs shall indicate the alley is one-way southbound to sufficiently advise vehicular traffic of the one-way alley; and shall install one-way signs at the intersection of the alleys between Chippewa and Washington Streets and Walnut and Allen Streets sufficient to warn vehicular traffic that the alley is one-way southbound.

4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Town Board of Trustees of the Town of Roann, Indiana, and the installation of the one-way signs by the Roann State Exchange Bank.
